The Rev. George Hull is a Diplomate in Clinical Pastoral Supervision and the former Associate General Secretary of the College of Pastoral Supervision & Psychotherapy. Rev. Hull served as the Chair of the Commission on Accreditation of Pastoral & Psychotherapy Training and as the Director of Pastoral Care and Clinical Pastoral Education Training at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences before coming to the Penney Memorial Church to serve as the Minister of Pastoral Care.
